What's next?



In November 2023, the Boards and Executive of Anglicare WA and Ruah met to scope opportunities to scale the learning from this project. There are a number of options to scale across different levels of the system. We're currently developing a roadmap which will encompass opportunities to create change across all levels of the system from 2024 onwards.

So far the discussion has been focused on four scaling options

or more broadly in the social sector.

Scale as a standalone Service Seek resourcing to replicate the Sunshine Project model as a standalone service offering.

Scale Practices
Transform existing teams to enable
more radical work within existing
contracts.

Scale the Conditions
Normalise the "special" conditions
at various levels of system that
enable radical work to thrive.
